POSITIVE YOUTH DEVELOPMENT.

We

Hold ourselves accountable for successful outcomes of the Littles in our program. Our 2014 Youth Outcome Survey results showed the following, compared to baseline statistics taken when youth entered the program:

76%

Improved or maintained in risk attitudes (such as skipping school and using drugs)

92%

Improved or maintained their trust towards their parents

72%

Improved or maintained in their educational expectations (that is, their belief that they can finish HS and go to college)




